How to Build up Body Paragraphs

In many places, new homes are needed, but the only space available for building them is in the countryside. Some people believe it is more important to protect the countryside and not build new homes there.

How to Build up Body Paragraphs

To begin with, new houses would destroy the countryside.

That is, if people destroy the countryside to build new houses, the result will be the loss of natural features.

A good example of this loss of natural features is cutting down hundreds of trees to build new houses.

Cutting down trees in turn will change the countryside completely.

To begin with, the most rational justification is that new houses would destroy the rural landscape. That is, if property developers turn these green areas into construction sites, the inevitable outcome will be the ultimate loss of countless irreplaceable natural features. A good illustration of this is felling hundreds of trees to free up enough space and lay the foundation for a few apartment blocks. This in turn will alter the appearance of the countryside beyond recognition and permanently which is an irreversible damage.

In addition, another argument against such plans is that the more people move to the countryside, **the more the environment will be affected**.

To put it differently, **the environment might be severely affected** by **human activities**.

Take waste for example; **people will continue to produce waste** which will probably be buried in the surrounding grounds that may already be a natural home of animals and plants.

In addition, another compelling argument against launching schemes of this nature is that the more people migrate to rural districts, the more the environment will be adversely affected. **To put it differently, the fragile ecology of these green belts is very susceptible to threats posed by human activities.** Take waste which has been a perennial problem for example; **households will continue to produce more and more rubbish which most probably will have to be buried in surrounding grounds that may already be a natural habitat for different species of animals and green vegetation.**
