Lecture 16 How to Avoid Overgeneralisations
Using Hedging

What is Overgeneralisation

Task Response 7 - presents, extends and supports main ideas, but there may be a tendency to overgeneralise and/or supporting ideas may lack focus

One logic error that can befall text is overgeneralization, the expansion of too few instances to many in a manner difficult to justify.

"No one gets band 7 in IELTS writing." an overgeneralization.

"I'm not a very good writer" not an overgeneralization.

How to avoid Overgeneralisation using Hedging

Living in another country is difficult.

Generally speaking, living in another country can be difficult.

Doing exams is stressful.

Doing exams tends to be stressful.

Learning a new language is the most challenging task.

In many cases, learning a new language is one of the most challenging tasks.

Living in a city is more convenient.

For many, living in a city is more convenient.

Prison will be more effective than a punishment.

In many instances, prison is highly likely to be more effective than a punishment.

Older people must be more conservative.

Older people should be more conservative.

How to avoid Overgeneralisation using Hedging

Using adverbs of frequency to soften language.

often, sometimes, usually, generally, typically

It is often said that children should not be allowed to use social networking sites. it is typically argued that social networking has a bad effect on young children's minds.

Using modals and modal adjectives

could, may, might, can, probable

It is typically argued that social networking may have a bad effect on young children's minds. Some people might argue that youngsters tend to be influenced more by their peers than their parents.

That clauses (useful in a discussion essay)

It could be argued that..., It is often assumed that..., There is a high probability that....

Some people hold the view that it is beneficial to share a lot of data especially in business, scientific research and academia, whereas others argue that certain information tends to be too important too share openly.
